"Becoming pregnant at eighteen was not part of the plan, my boyfriend and I had just broken up, The dream was to move to NY, and attend a Community College, I wanted to go into hospitality or become a photographer. Life got rerouted, I found out I was pregnant when I was two months," shares preemie mom, Diane Rodriguez.

"I went into early labor. I was 31 wks. I arrived to the hospital and I was already 7cm dilated!

My son was ready to see the world. My son was taken to the NICU, was intubated, had a nasogastric tube in his nose, he had monitors for his heart. I went to visit him at the NICU, I did not know what to expect, I was so anxious."
