66 "On May 23rd, at 2:00am, was the day my water broke. I was 27 weeks and 4 days into my pregnancy," recalls mom, Karen Quintero.

"As we were in the midst of the Covid-19 pandemic, I was not allowed to go into the ER with anyone else to see if I was in labor and to find out what was going on. Let me remind you, I am a first-time mom and never did I think I would be able to have a baby, so all this was unbelievable and when my water broke, I was completely clueless as to what was going to happen to us."

Hand to Hold helps families before, during and after a NICU stay or in the event of infant loss.

Kelli Kelley founded Hand to Hold in 2010 after her son, Jackson, was born in August of 2000, weighing just a pound and a half at 24 weeks. Her daughter, Lauren, was born at 34 weeks and also required a NICU stay. Kelley suffered from psychosocial issues for years after her children's early births. "I don't ever want another NICU parent to feel alone like I felt," she says.
