Unlike a single-incident trauma, life in the NICU is a continuous series of traumas: a terrifying birthing experience, your baby's fragile health, the stream of bad news about your baby's health and future prognosis, and especially hard for parents - a sense of helplessness as a medical team of experts try to keep your child alive.

## **AFTER THE NICU**

While parents look forward to their preemie being discharged, often the stress will follow them home due to continued health problems and future unknowns. Add trauma from the NICU and it's common for parents of preemies to find themselves feeling emotional distress and more. Here are some signs of PTSD and tips to help you through this:

- Common symptoms of PTSD: Recurrent, unwanted distressing memories of the traumatic event, nightmares, flashbacks or reliving the traumatic event, intense distress or physical reactions to memory triggers, negative changes in mood and thinking, changes in emotional reactions.
- Be aware of triggers: Some triggers may include follow-up appointments, fear of the baby becoming sick, alarm sounds, fear of leaving the house with the baby and feelings of isolation and loneliness.

"From the day he was born, Bryce has been fighting for his life. Proving the desire to live is something you are born with and deservingly he was nicknamed "Tiny but Mighty," shares Bryce's dad.
