AFTER THE NICU

February was named American Heart Month by the American Heart Association and February 7-14th is Congenital Heart Defects (CHD) Awareness Week. Nearly 1 in 110 babies is born with a heart defect in the United States each year. About 1 in 4 babies born with a heart defect (about 25 percent) has a critical CHD.
